Title (Swedish) Abstract	
Chemotaxis Inhibitory Protein of <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i> (CHIPS) is a protein that inhibits migration of neutrophils to the site of infection by binding to and blocking signalling from the C5a receptor. CHIPS may function as an anti-inflammatory therapeutic compound. Screening for CHIPS variants with increased affinity for the C5aR was performed using phage display, followed by sequencing of interesting clones.
